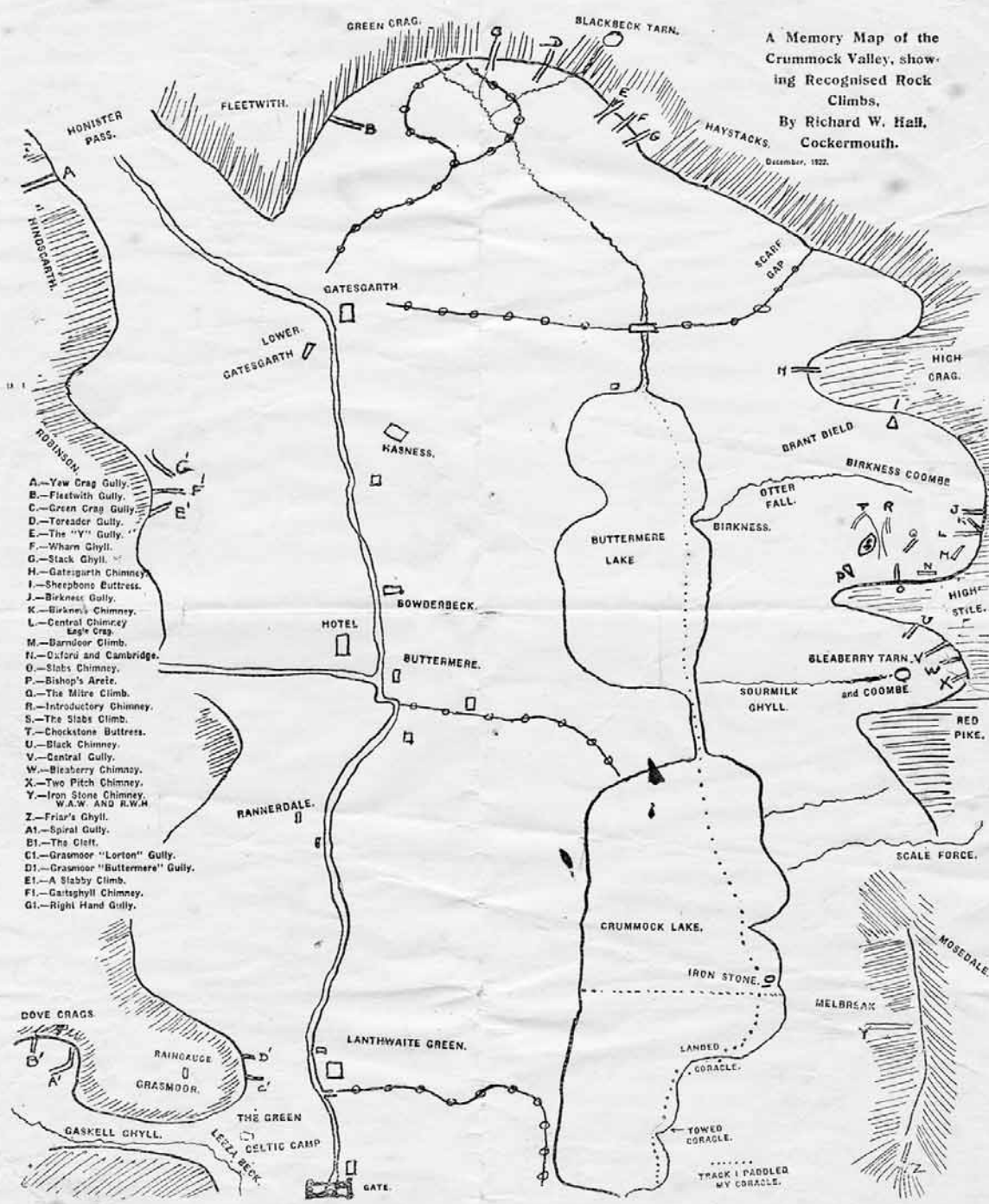


A Memory Map of the
