From 1810, John Marshall, the Leeds millowner, created many Lake District estates which would later come to the National Trust. In 1795 he married Jane Pollard, the life-long best friend of Dorothy Wordsworth. The curious relationship between John Marshall and William Wordsworth will be discussed, during their unlikely co-operation in building the Marshall estates around Buttermere, Crummock, Loweswater, and Derwentwater.
